Annette Bugnet, CPP Environmental, Fire Chiefs Raymond Brousseau, James Preston and Trevor Kotowich and Deputy Fire Chief Henri Thompson entered the Council meeting at 11:00 a.m.

Annette provided the results of the Wildfire Hazard and Risk Assessment for the County of St. Paul. She informed Council that she visited 56 communities, and only one community was determined to be at a high risk. She recommended that the next step is educating the public and providing mitigation strategies and how to mitigate their risks for each strategy. The delegation discussed starting the education process at

Block Parties to be held by the FCSS Department this summer at various locations throughout the County.

The delegation is concerned that the landowner drained the sloughs and diverted the water, and now it becomes a cost to the County to take care of the water. Mr. Brodziak also informed Council that he is concerned with the possibility of clubroot being transferred to the creek and to other fields.

The delegation provided pictures and a video showing the water adjacent to the road.

Public Works will look at the culvert in the spring and determine whether the water is affecting the County infrastructure, before deciding how to proceed.
