

6c. **11:30 A.M. DELEGATION – PERRY ZYLA**

Perry Zyla and Robert Haig, residents of the Paziuk Development were admitted to the Council Room to request that the old launch road on the Paziuk development be reopened. The road serves as access to the lake for back low owners. They would like quad access and truck access a couple times a year to remove lifts out of the water.

Moved by Councillor M. Fodness that the Public Works Department remove the posts on the old launch road at the Paziuk Development in accordance with section 664(1) of the Municipal Government Act on the condition that the ER is not being abused; abuse of the ER will be determined by the number of Public complaints. Carried.
