The hall is also in need of upgrades and it is felt at this time, it would be too costly to head in this direction. For several years, the Armistice Community Hall has stood as a pillar in our neighbourhood. From its weekend dances, to its well-known Nov. Dine and Dance, the hall has served as a meeting place for neighbours and friends for decades. It will be sadly missed by all, but fondly remembered.


Again, we regret our decision to discontinue operating the community hall, but feel this is our only alternative at this time. We are submitting this letter to county council for their review and look forward to a response.
