The Edmonton New Church Society (ENCS) is requesting a waterline installation, to supply our property with clean water. Currently we rely on a pump well to deliver water for washing dishes, showering, and bottled water for drinking.

Due to the close proximity of the Ashmont Waste Management Facility, and the age of the well on the property, we are concerned about water quality.

The ENCS, along with the Paulhaven Property Committee (PPC) are requesting a waterline installation from TW 595 and RR 112, approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to 59517 Rge Rd 112. The ENCS is asking for a 50/50 split with the county, amortizing over 20 years. This projects budget is for 2018.

Bryan Bespalko, with St. Paul Public Works, has been a contact in the planning of this project. He has given us valuable information about the logistics and costs surrounding this project.

Residents of Cameron Cove, have shown some interest in bringing the line further into their community.

History

This 40 acre parcel of land was donated to the ENCS by Paul Tremblay in the early 50s. In 1961 Paulhaven was created as a church retreat. Since then the property has been used by the Western Canada Conference (WCC) as a summer residents for all members from Western Canada.
