

PUBLIC NOTICE TO ELECTORS
of the
COUNTY OF ST. PAUL NO. 19, PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

Section 251 of the Municipal Government Act

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the County of St. Paul No. 19, in the Province of Alberta, has given first reading to Borrowing Bylaw No. 2017-02 which will, upon final passage and approval authorize the proper officers of the said County to borrow monies from the Alberta Capital Finance Authority or another authorized Financial Institution, by way of debenture to finance bringing a water supply to the Hamlet of Mallaig.

The total cost of the aforesaid project amounts to \$10,200,000. After deducting from this cost the amount of \$4,750,000 to be paid by federal funding, \$4,729,880 to be paid by provincial funding, the net amount to be borrowed on the credit and security of the municipality at large by the issue of debentures is \$720,120. The debentures are to be repayable to the Alberta Capital Finance Authority or other authorized Financial Institution, by way of semi-annual or annual equal payments of combined principal and interest installments not to exceed thirty (30) years calculated at a rate not exceeding the interest rate fixed by the Alberta Capital Finance Authority or another authorized financial institution on the date of borrowing, and not to exceed eight (8) percent;

NOW THEREFORE NOTICE is hereby given by the Council of the County of St. Paul that, unless a petition of the electors for a vote on Bylaw No. 2017-02 is demanded, as provided for by the terms of Section 231 of the Municipal Government Act, the said Council may pass the said Borrowing Bylaw.

All persons interested are hereby notified and they are required to govern themselves accordingly,

INFORMATION OF ELECTORS

Pursuant to Section 1(i) of the Municipal Government Act an “elector” means:

A person who is eligible to vote in the election for a councilor under the Local Authorities Election Act.

Pursuant to Section 47(1) of the Local Authorities Election Act a person is eligible to vote in an election if he:

1. is at least 18 years old

2. is a Canadian citizen, and
3. has resided in Alberta for the 6 consecutive months immediately preceding election day and is resident in the area on election day.

A poll may be demanded in the County of St. Paul by electors equal in number to at least:

1. in the case of a municipality other than a summer village, by electors of the municipality equal in number to at least 10% of the population and
2. in the case of a summer village, by 10% of the electors of the summer village.

in accordance with the provisions of section 223 of the Municipal Government Act and in accordance with the provisions of section 251 of the Municipal Government Act.

The petition for a vote must be received by the Chief Administrative Officer within 15 days of the last publication of this notice and shall contain on each page “an accurate and identical statement of the purpose of the petition”. (Further requirements of the petition are provided in section 224 of the Municipal Government Act.)
