ANNUAL GRANDPARENT DAY CELEBRATION

Elk Point and surrounding communities take this opportunity to recognize Grandparents Day which falls on the second Sunday in September. Come join us in celebrating and honouring our Grandparents who help support us, who love us unconditionally and are a very important part of keeping our families together.

The Walk has two focuses:

- 1. To recognize the wisdom and valuable contributions of grandparents.
- 2. As a fund-raiser.
 - 2.1 1/3 of the proceeds will go towards Elk Point Pioneer Circle to help with their utility bills.
 - 2.2 1/3 of the proceeds will go to Heritage Lodge Auxiliary to help pay operational costs of the Handi-Van Bus.
 - 2.3 1/3 of the proceeds will go towards supporting African Grandparents in the Lushoto District of Tanzania, Africa. Because of the death-toll of A.I.D.S. they now have to look after their grandchildren. Many of them, with no means of support, are trying to feed and educate up to 11 grandchildren themselves.

Drayton Valley Community Foundation – Lushoto Project; has built an orphanage which is run by the Sisters of Charity and are presently engaged in upgrading the local school by providing water and electricity.

It requires approximately \$750.00 to feed one family and send a child to secondary school for one year where they have the opportunity to get an education that can lead to a profession such as nursing or teaching. This can change their lives, the lives of their brothers and sisters and community at large. Our goal is to try and raise enough money to help 10 families. The money will go directly to the families and school via the Drayton Valley Foundation volunteers who go to Lushoto, Tanzania, Africa up to twice per year (at their own expense) to oversee the progress.
